

## **ROLCC Board Meeting Minutes May 5, 2022**

### **1. Financial Update**

- Approximately \$600 Short in dues this season
- 2 members still need to pay their dues for this season. Board members will reach out to them individually
- Amazon Smiles - have about \$20 in donations. Need to remind the choir to
- Kim and Bekki will address the choir during the next rehearsal and ask for donations
- Lisa will send an email to the entire choir distribution list inviting everyone to the concert and announcing the dates of the Fall Session. She will also ask for donations from the larger group.

### **2. Concert - "A Night at the Movies" June 4, 7 PM Highlands Lutheran**

- Kim will verify with the Church that we are able to have our dress rehearsal on Friday, June 3rd and our concert on June 4th
- Possible to have sponsorships on the program.
- Will promote the Fall Session at the June concert. Bekki will create flyers for the concert and the Fall Session.
- Lisa will work on the program and verify how choir members want their names listed. Kim will forward the QR codes to include on the concert program.
- Because of COVID concerns, we will not have a reception after the concert, but we will invite members to go out for a drink after.
- Possibility of including soloists during the concert. Katie asked to sing a solo, so we should open it up to members of the choir. Limit to two soloist, and they must meet the following requirements:

- Music must meet the theme of the program
- Music must be given to Brenda immediately
- Limit to two soloist for the Spring 2022 concert
- Must audition to Charles, and he will decide

### **3. Fall Session 2022**

- Dates for Fall rehearsals, Tuesday, September 6th - November 29th, with concert on December 3rd
- Need 25 members in the choir paying \$80 dues to break even for the season. Set a goal to have 10 new members for the Fall Session.
- Ask members such as Dustin to invite people to join choir
- Have a summer social such as a karaoke event to keep the momentum going.

### **4. Fundraising for Next Season**

- Include QR codes in the June concert, asking for donations
- List of possible fundraising events include cabaret, dinner theater
- Also need to pursue grants, sponshipships
- Most importantly, need to recruit new members!
