He has also sung over 45 operatic roles with numerous companies including Wichita Grand Opera, Opera Kansas, Eugene Opera, Des Moines Metro Opera, Knoxville Opera, and the Texas Gilbert and Sullivan Company.

Dr. Turley presently teaches private voice lessons, directs several choirs, and is involved in children's musical theater programs in the Denver metroplex.
